- China launches third and final module for Tiangong space station. The module, named Mengtian or "dreaming of the heavens" was launched on a Long March 5B rocket from the Wenchang launch centre on China's tropical island Hainan
- The **United States** is planning to **deploy up to six nuclear capable B-52 bombers** to an **air base in northern Australia**, amid heightened tensions with China
- Black sea is a marginal Mediterranean sea of the Atlantic Ocean lying between Europe and Asia, east of the Balkans, south of the East European Plain, west of the Caucasus, and north of Anatolia. It is bounded by Bulgaria, Georgia, Romania, Russia, Turkey, and Ukraine.

- Elon Musk-owned SpaceX launched the Falcon Heavy rocket into a geosynchronous Earth orbit from the Launch. It is considered as the most powerful operational rocket in the world
- The Matera Declaration, G20 ministers recognised that **poverty alleviation**, food security, and sustainable food systems are key to ending hunger
- The black sea grain intiative the deal was to provide for a safe maritime humanitarian corridor for Ukrainian exports (particularly for food grains) from three of its key ports, namely, Chornomorsk, Odesa and Yuzhny/Pivdennyi. The central idea was to calm markets by ensuring an adequate supply of grains, thereby limiting food price inflation
- A plane operated by Tanzania's Precision Air crash-landed into Lake Victoria on approach to the lakeside city of Bukoba
- The European Union (EU) enacted Digital Services Act (DSA). The DSA regulates intermediary liability in the EU. The DSA also gives intermediaries an opportunity to challenge the government's decision to block content and defend themselves
- **UAE and Egypt** agreed to **develop one of the world's largest wind farms** in a deal struck on the sidelines of COP -27 summit
- The **IMF reached a preliminary agreement** to provide **Banglades**h with a \$4.5 billion support package to help it cope with soaring energy and food prices. Bangladesh plans to use the IMF loan to prop up its foreign exchange reserves
- FloodHub provides Google Flood Alerts to the general population.
- UNCLOS is an international agreement that establishes a legal framework for all marine and maritime activities. Parties of 167 countries and the European Union. The United Nations Secretariat has no direct operational role in the implementation of the Convention. International Whaling Commission and the International Seabed Authority (ISA), which was established by the Convention itself.
- The Hong Kong International Convention for the safe and environmentally sound recycling of ships is a multilateral convention adopted in 2009, which has not entered into force. It has been designed to improve the health and safety of current ship breaking practices.
- Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi along with other G-20 Leaders visited and planted Mangroves at the 'Taman Hutan Raya Ngurah Rai' Mangrove forests on the sidelines of G-20 Summit in Bali
- Black Sea Grain Initiative is an agreement between Russia and Ukraine with Turkey and the United Nations (UN) made during the 2022 Russian invasion of Ukraine. The agreement created procedures to safely export grain from certain ports to attempt to address the 2022 food crisis
- After assuming the G20 Presidency, **Prime minister Narendra Modi to assume** the Chair of Global Partnership on AI (GPAI)
- India has become the only country to receive the Leadership in Family Planning EXCELL Awards-2022 at an international conference held in Thailand. The award

- **conferred in the 'country' category** recognised India's efforts in improving access to modern family planning methods
- Persian Gulf is a mediterranean sea in Western Asia. It is a extension of the Indian
 Ocean located between Iran and the Arabian Peninsula, connects to the Gulf of
 Oman in the east by the Strait of Hormuz.
- India wins the International Electro technical Commission (IEC) Vice Presidency and Strategic Management Board (SMB) Chair for the 2023-25 term held recently in San Francisco
- Chin –Kuki –Mizo ethnic communities are associated with Bangladesh
- The Russian state owned nuclear energy corporation Rosatom has offered a more advanced fuel option to India's largest nuclear power station at Kudankulam, allow its reactors to run for an extended two-year cycle without stopping to load fresh fuel





- Mauna Loa, world's largest active volcano, started to erupt in Hawaii
- Ethiopia's and Tigray warring sides agreed to a permanent cessation of hostilities in a 2-year armed conflict
- Almost eight million people in South Sudan, or two thirds of the population in the country, are at risk of hunger, the United Nations warned in a report. One of the world's poorest nations, South Sudan has spent more than half of its life as a nation of civil war

Environment & ECOLOGY NEWS

- Miyawaki is a technique pioneered by Japanese botanist Akira Miyawaki, that helps build dense, native urban forests. The approach is supposed to ensure that plant growth is 10 times faster and the resulting plantation is 30 times denser than usual. This technique works worldwide irrespective of soil and climatic conditions
- An **invasive species, Senna spectabilis**, an exotic tree, has taken the buffer zones of the **Mudumalai Tiger Reserve (MTR)** in the Nilgiris hill district.
- Eravikulam national park will convert to green energy model over the next couple
 of years. In the first phase, the camp sheds of the park have switched to solar
 power
- Ranipur Tiger Reserve in Uttar Pradesh has become the **53rd tiger reserve in India**.
- COP-27 puts climate compensation on agenda for first time
- A new species of endemic honeybee has been discovered in the Western Ghats
- Researchers have discovered a new species of estuarine crab at the mangroves of Parangipettai near the Vellar river in Cuddalore district of Tamil Nadu. The species has been named Pseudohelice annamalai in recognition of Annamalai University's 100 years of service in education and research
- Greenwashing is an unsubstantiated claim to deceive consumers into believing that a company's products are environmentally friendly or have a greater positive environmental impact than what is true
- **Sri Lankan President Ranil Wickremesinghe** on proposed setting up an international climate change university in Sri Lanka, with an ancillary institution in the Maldives in COP -27
- The government gave nod to the final sovereign green bonds framework in line with the Budget announcement.
- At the COP27, the Mangrove Alliance for Climate (MAC) was launched, an initiative led by the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Indonesia, the Mangrove Alliance for Climate (MAC) includes India, Sri Lanka, Australia, Japan, and Spain
- Solar Energy Corporation of India (only Central Public Sector Undertaking (PSU)
 dedicated to the solar energy sector under ministry of New and Renewable
 Energy) participates in COP 27, Egypt
- The Himalayan grey langur is an Endangered (leaf eating monkey) confined to the Chamba Valley of the Western Himalayas in Himachal Pradesh state in India
- Kalatop Khajjiar Sanctuary is a animal sanctuary at Kalatop and Khajjiar in the Chamba district of Himachal Pradesh with dense deodar and fir forest, surrounded by coniferous and oak forests .River ravi flows through it
- The GreenVoyage2050 Project is a partnership project between the Government of Norway and IMO launched in May 2019 aiming to transform the shipping industry towards a lower carbon future.

- The Global Shield(GS), coordinated by G7 president Germany, aims to provide rapid access for climate-vulnerable countries to insurance and disaster protection funding after floods or drought. It is being developed in collaboration with the 'V20' group of 58 climate vulnerable economies. Germany is the largest contributor
- Okhla Bird sanctuary is situated in **Noida**, **Gautam Buddh Nagar district**, on Delhi-Uttar Pradesh state border on **river of Yamuna** established under the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972. It is **now one of the Important Bird Areas in India**.
- A carbon border adjustment tax is a duty on imports based on the amount of carbon emissions resulting from the production of the product in question. It is proposed by EU
- India communicated strong objections to discussions under a special UNFCCC effort known as the Koronivia Joint Work on Agriculture, that sought to expand efforts to reduce emissions of greenhouses gases to the agriculture sector
- Flowering in Melocanna baccifera, a tropical bamboo species that has fascinated researchers for its association with the occurrence of 'bamboo death,' 'rat foods' and famines in northeast India
- UN climate summit in Egypt(COP27) on created history by deciding to establish a fund to address loss and damage
- The 19th meeting of the Conference of Parties CITES is being held in the scenic city of Panama
